

**MOTION FOR DECISION ON RECORD AND WAIVER OF HEARING**

Atmos Energy Corporation (Atmos Energy), by counsel, moves for a decision on the record in this matter and waives a hearing. The Commission issued an order on January 26, 2023, giving parties an opportunity to request a hearing or submit the case on the record on or before February 28, 2023. There are no intervenors in the case. Atmos Energy responded to the Staff's initial data request. No subsequent data request was issued.

The issues in this case are similar to those raised in Atmos Energy's prior shelf offerings in Case Nos. 2019-00421 and 2021-00193. Given the thoroughness of the Commission's data requests and the similarity of issues from prior cases, Atmos Energy believes the record is adequate for purposes of reviewing, evaluating and deciding the proposed shelf registration.


A decision on the record will expedite the issuance of the final order. Given that Atmos Energy has almost utilized all the authority under the current shelf registration, timing of the new registration is a critical factor in obtaining optimal financing. Additionally, elimination of an evidentiary hearing will save both Atmos Energy and the Commission time, effort, and expense.

For these reasons, Atmos Energy moves for a decision on the record.
