#### **Supplemental Information Filing**

Nicholas County Water District ("Nicholas District"), by counsel, hereby files this Supplemental Information Filing informing the Commission of a change in circumstances, as follows:

On February 10, 2023, Nicholas District tendered an application, pursuant to KRS 278.023 requesting (i) a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN") to construct a system improvements project; (ii) authorization to issue securities; and (iii) approval of a change in rates. The Commission issued its Order granting the requested relief on March 10, 2023.

Construction bids were opened on September 13, 2022 and said bids came in approximately \$717,000 over budget. After much deliberation, Nicholas District decided to delete certain items from the bids in order to allow the project to proceed within the available funding. These deletions included the elimination of East Union pump station replacement (see Section 6 - proposed project recommended alternative of the Final Engineering Report filed with the original Application). Attached hereto as **Exhibit "A"** is a letter of explanation from Bluegrass Engineering, PLLC, engineers for Nicholas District.

Subsequent to the issuance of the Commission's March 10, 2023 Order, Nicholas District applied for additional funding through the Cleaner Water Grant ("CWG") program and on or about June 29, 2023 received an award from the Kentucky Infrastructure Authority ("KIA") of \$200,000 of CWG funds (see KIA conditional commitment letter attached hereto as "**Exhibit** "**B**"). Subsequent to such award, Nicholas District received an additional award of \$80,000 of CWG funds (a KIA conditional commitment letter has not been issued yet). The additional CWG funds has allowed Nicholas District to add the East Union pump station replacement back into the Project. Bluegrass Engineering, PLLC revised the final project budget (see revised page 6-5 of the Final Engineering Report attached hereto as **Exhibit "C"**) to include the CWG funds. On September 12, 2023, USDA, Rural Development ("RD") has issued Amendment No. 2 to the original Letter of Conditions revising the Project Budget and Project Funding to include the CWG funds received by Nicholas District (see **Exhibit "D"** attached hereto).

Nicholas District files this Supplemental Information Filing in the Post Case file in an effort to inform the Commission on the change in circumstances since the original Order was issued.

The undersigned has prepared this Supplemental Information Filing as Counsel to and on behalf of Nicholas County Water District, a governmental agency, and hereby certifies that this Response is true and accurate to the best of the undersign's knowledge, information and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

Re: Phase 12 Water System Improvements – Contracts 1 & 2 Nicholas County Water District

Dear Mr. Jones;

Pursuant to our conversation, please find within this correspondence a brief synopsis of the budgetary changes for the above referenced project.

Nicholas County Water District opened bids on September 13, 2022. The low bidders were Tilton Excavating (Contract 1) with a bid of \$1,556,392, and Ferguson Water (Contract 2) with a bid of \$722,000.20. The project budget of \$1,925,000 was developed in 2020 prior to the inflationary pricing of materials and labor, therefore the bids came in over at \$717,000.

The District desperately needed the new meters, therefore we moved forward with the project deleting items that would bring us within budget. As we waited for Rural Development to review the project (ten months), the Cleaner Water Funding (rounds 1 and 2) became available, therefore we were able to obtain another \$280,000 in grant funds for the project. This additional funding allowed NCWD to add one of the deleted pump stations back into the project.

The amount of funding available is \$2,205,000. This allows \$1,783,200 to be earmarked for construction.
