Notice is hereby given that the Meade County Water District expects to file an application with the Kentucky Public Service Commission on or about February 10, 2023, seeking approval of a proposed adjustment to its water rates. The proposed rates shall not become effective until the Public Service Commission has issued an order approving these rates.

If the Public Service Commission approves the proposed water rates, then the monthly bill for Doe Valley Water using an average of 5,870,000 gallons per month will increase from \$34,867.80 to \$35,807.00. This is an increase of \$939.20 or 2.69%. If the proposed rates are approved, then the monthly bill for Otter Creek Water using an average of 320,000 gallons per month will increase from \$1,945.60 to \$1,996.80. This is an increase of \$51.20 or 2.63%.

The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by Meade County Water District. However, the Public Service Commission may order rates to be charged that differ from these proposed rates. Such action may result in rates for consumers other than the rates shown in this notice.

Meade County Water District has available for inspection at its office the application which it submitted to the Public Service Commission. If the Public Service Commission does not receive a written request for intervention within thirty (30) days of the initial publication of this notice, the Public Service Commission may take final action on the application.
