Report on the Audit of the Financial Statements

Opinions

We have audited the accompanying financial statements of the governmental activities of the City of Camargo, Kentucky, as of and for the year ended June 30, 2022, and the related notes to the financial statements, which collectively comprise the City of Camargo, Kentucky's basic financial statements as listed in the table of contents.

In our opinion, the financial statements referred to above present fairly, in all material respects, the respective financial position of the governmental activities of the City of Camargo, Kentucky, as of June 30, 2022, and the respective changes in financial position, thereof for the year then ended in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.

Basis for Opinions

We conducted our audit in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America and the standards applicable to financial audits contained in *Government Auditing Standards*, issued by the Comptroller General of the United States. Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements section of our report. We are required to be independent of the City of Camargo, Kentucky.

NOTICE

Delta Natural Gas Company, Inc. ("Delta") provides notice that it is filing with the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") no later than March 20, 2023 in Case No. 2023-00076 to establish a monthly surcharge with an effective date of May 1, 2023 to recover the remaining balances associated with gas costs for Delta and the former Peoples Gas of KY LLC ("Peoples") system prior to the unification of the gas cost recovery mechanisms as approved in the Commission's January 3, 2022 Order in Case No. 2021-00185. Delta proposes to recover the balances through a monthly surcharge of \$.87 per Mcf for Delta customers and \$.74 per Mcf for the former Peoples customers. The balance would be recovered from Delta customers over approximately three years, and approximately two years from the former Peoples customers. The surcharge shall terminate when the balances are recovered.

The surcharge is proposed to apply to Residential, Small Non-residential, Large Non-Residential, Interruptible, and Farm Tap customers. The revenues requested in this filing are recovery of the remaining balances, which for Delta customers is \$8,160,521, and \$320,990 for the former Peoples customers.

If the Commission does not receive a written request for intervention within thirty (30) days of the initial publication or mailing of this notice, the Commission may take final action on the filing.
