The Lake Village Water Association submits the following response to the Public Service Commission Order for Case No. 2023-00107. The Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity application included a request from the Association to maintain the rates that are currently in effect from Case No. 2022-00068. The Association would like to clarify the request included in the application, specifically that the Phase 2 rates ordered by the Public Service Commission stayed in effect and were not reduced to the rates found in the Rural Development Letter of Conditions. Due to the timing of the Alternate Rate Filing application and Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity application, the Association was uncertain of how the Commission would set the rates since the Phase 2 rates were approved and higher than the rates found in the Rural Development Letter of Conditions.

The Association is aware of the four-month period in which the rates will be less than the Rural Development Letter of Conditions and is agreeable to implementing the rates found in the Rural Development Letter of Conditions with Public Service Commission concurrence and approval. Additional correspondence or modifications that would affect the requirements found in the Rural Development Letter of Conditions is not anticipated. The Association's objective is to comply with all project requirements set forth by the Public Service Commission and Rural Development. Upon approval by the Public Service Commission, the rates found in the Rural Development Letter of Conditions will be placed in effect until the Phase 2 rates are placed in effect on October 4, 2023.
