The Lake Village Water Association submits the following response to the Public Service Commission Order for Case No. 2023-00107 dated June 6, 2023. The June 6, 2023 Order included rates for service effective May 3, 2023. In the Order, the Commission requested an explanation of how the Association will ensure that the rates approved were properly charged to the customers. The Association is unable to charge two different rates for service within the same billing period, so the rates effective on May 3, 2023 were placed into effective at the first opportunity on May 12, 2023. The first full billing cycle after the effective date of the rates began on May 12, 2023 and ended on June 12, 2023. Monthly water bills based on the May 3, 2023 rates for service were mailed to all customers on June 28, 2023 and are due by July 15, 2023.

The rates for service included in the June 6, 2023 Order were advertised in the June 28, 2023 publication of the Harrodsburg Herald. The advertisement is attached for reference.
