The circumstances that led to the decision to purchase the property are detailed in the response filed on June 19, 2023.

The Union County Water District has rented from the Union County Fiscal Court an office building at 409 North Court Street since 2008. The building had begun to need repair and updating. UCWD Manager Gary Sheffer approached County Judge/Executive Adam Onan about making much needed repairs. The discussion came about whether the Union County Fiscal Court would possibly sell the property to UCWD at a reasonable cost to help offset the upgrades needed to the building. After discussion with the UCWD Board members we agreed to purchase the building if the price was agreeable. The Fiscal court agreed to sell the property for \$50,000. This seemed to be a good move for the Water District to own instead of rent. The UCWD Board and its Manager believed that purchasing the building was a good business decision. Therefore, UCWD obtained a loan for the purchase price plus \$25,000 for needed upgrades and repair.

In addition, the County had approached UCWD on two occasions several years ago about possibly moving out so that the County's emergency management agency could occupy the building. UCWD believed that purchasing the building would also secure the office and avoid future disruption or increased rent.
