Dear Ms. Bridwell:

Enclosed please find an Electronic Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN") to enable Kentucky Utilities Company (the "Company") to apply for an electric franchise with the City of Lynch (the "City") pursuant to KRS 278.020(4). Pursuant to Ordinance No. 021423, the City Council of Lynch, Kentucky was directed to advertise for bids for the sale of an electric franchise in the City. The Company asks that the Commission enter an Order granting a CPCN to bid for and acquire a franchise from the City on or before June 13, 2023. For many years, the Company has been the owner of a franchise granted by the City to erect facilities for providing electric service to the City and the inhabitants thereof. The franchise to be obtained will replace the previous franchise.

In accordance with the Commission's Order of December 2, 2021 in Case No. 2020-00085 (Electronic Emergency Docket Related to the Novel Coronavirus COVID-19), this is to certify that the electronic filing has been transmitted to the Commission on May 8, 2023, and that there are currently no parties in this proceeding that the Commission has excused from participation by electronic means.
