A mechanism that permits jurisdictional utilities to regularly adjust the price of electricity to reflect fluctuations in the cost of fuel, or purchased power, used to supply that electricity.

**Fuel Adjustment**      LG&E/KU –  
Electric Only

Variable charge or credit based on rising (charge) or falling (credit) fuel costs associated with generating electricity. Can change monthly; calculated per kilowatt hour (kWh) used.

The electric rate includes a set amount to cover possible higher actual costs due to price fluctuations. The fuel adjustment addresses any under or over collection of base fuel costs each month.
