RE: <u>Kentucky Power Company's Second Revised Tariff Sheet 35-1 (Tariff F.T.C.)</u>

Dear Ms. Bridwell:

Kentucky Power Company ("Kentucky Power" or "Company") files herewith redline and annotated versions of P.S.C. KY. NO. 13 2<sup>nd</sup> Revised Tariff Sheet 35-1 (Federal Tax Cut or "F.T.C.") as part of its annual update in compliance with the Commission's January 19, 2024 Order in Case No. 2023-00159.<sup>1</sup>

Kentucky Power is updating the applicable Tariff F.T.C. rate on a kWh basis (*see* paragraph 5 of proposed Tariff F.T.C.) and retail revenue for residential (RR), all other classes (OR), and total retail revenue (R) (*see* paragraph 6 of proposed Tariff F.T.C.). The proposed tariff further includes within the F.T.C. mechanism the annual ADIT benefit related to non-Decommissioning Rider regulatory assets that were securitized on June 12, 2025, including the Tariff P.P.A. Under-Recovery Regulatory Asset, the Rockport Deferral Regulatory Asset, and the storm expense regulatory assets. The Commission ordered, consistent with the settlement agreement in Case No. 2023-00159, that "the proposal to include the annual actual impact of the ADIT for these regulatory assets in Tariff F.T.C. is reasonable and should be approved. This approach will ensure that customers benefit from the associated ADIT in a reasonable manner over the life of the ADIT."<sup>2</sup>
