
**NOTICE OF FILING LOAN DOCUMENTS AND
REQUEST TO REINSTATE THE APPLICATION FOR
DECLARATORY ORDER**

Comes now Burkesville Gas Company, Inc. (“Burkesville”) by and through the undersigned counsel, pursuant to the Commission’s October 6, 2023 Order in the above-styled case and requests the Commission to reinstate the portion of Burkesville’s Application for a Declaratory Order regarding its Small Business Administration (“SBA”) loan. As grounds for this request, Burkesville states that the Commission’s October 6, 2023 Order dismissed Burkesville’s request for a declaratory order without prejudice because the Commission did not have a copy of the SBA loan documents to review. Burkesville is filing the SBA loan documents contemporaneously with this request. As the Commission will see, the loan was funded, serviced and administered by the SBA.

Therefore, Burkesville requests that the Commission reinstate and grant the request of Burkesville Gas, that was dismissed without prejudice, to enter a declaratory order that Commission approval was not required for the SBA loan.


