**KENTUCKY AMERICAN WATER COMPANY’S**  
**MOTION FOR INFORMAL CONFERENCE**

Kentucky American Water Company (“KAW” or the “Company”) hereby moves the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“Commission”) pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(4) to schedule an informal conference in the above-referenced proceeding. In support of its Motion, KAW states as follows:

Contemporaneously with the filing of this Motion, KAW has filed a Petition for Rehearing regarding five calculation issues in the Commission’s May 3, 2024 Order. The Company included exhibits to its Petition for Rehearing outlining the impact of the calculation errors on KAW’s revenue requirement. KAW believes an informal conference may assist Commission Staff in the efficient review and evaluation of the Petition for Rehearing, and more particularly, the exhibits outlining the impacts of the errors. Representatives of the Company will be available to answer the questions of Commission Staff and any intervening party regarding the Petition for Rehearing. KAW is willing to appear either in-person at the Commission’s offices or remotely by video conference.

**WHEREFORE**, Kentucky American Water Company respectfully requests that the Commission schedule an informal conference in this matter.




