MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Comes now Black Mountain Utility District, (“Black Mountain”), by and through counsel, and respectfully requests the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“Commission”) grant a 2-day extension of time, until January 17, 2024, to provide the monthly reports required to be filed pursuant to the Commission’s October 9, 2023 Order in the above-styled case. In support of this motion, Black Mountain respectfully states as follows:


1. On October 9, 2023, the Commission issued an Order to monitor Black Mountain’s Unaccounted for Water Loss Reduction Plan and Surcharge (“October 9th Order”).
2. The Commission’s October 9th Order directed Black Mountain to file certain documentation by the 15th day of each month.
3. The 15th day of January, 2024 was a holiday and Black Mountain was unable to get the statement from its bank to file into the record of this proceeding. In addition, Black Mountain suffered inclement weather on January 16, 2024 and was unable to get the required printout from the bank until January 17, 2024.

4. Black Mountain filed the required information on January 17, 2024 and is requesting the Commission to grant it a 2-day extension for the January 2024 filing in this proceeding.

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, Black Mountain respectfully requests that the Commission grant it a 2-day extension, until January 17, 2024, to file the information required by its October 9th Order.


