

## NOTICE OF NEW RATE

Jessamine-South Elkhorn Water District gives notice of a change to its schedule of rates due solely to an increase in sewage treatment fees by the Lexington Fayette Urban County Government. These new charges will apply to all sanitary sewer customers of the District. The effective date of the Phase 1 adjusted charges was July 1, 2023; Phase 2 adjusted, August 25, 2023.

The dollar amount of the change is \$0.51 per 1,000 gallons and the percentage change is 3.38% for Phase 1, and 3.04% for Phase 2. Our customers used an average of 6,046 gallons per month over the past year, and the requested change will cause the average bill to increase to \$94.54 for Phase 1, and \$104.91 for Phase 2.

The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by Jessamine-South Elkhorn Water District, but the Public Service Commission may order rates to be charged that differ from the proposed rates contained in this notice. A person may submit a timely written request for intervention to the Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 615, Frankfort, Kentucky 40602, establishing the grounds for the request including the status and interest of the party.
