All additional MCF	\$9.00 per metric cubic foot

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RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Bills for service will be rendered monthly, the term "month" shall mean the period between consecutive meter readings which shall be taken, as nearly as possible, every thirty (30) days.

2. Bills are rendered within 10 days following each billing period. Service shall not be discontinued to any customer for nonpayment of charges unless the gas company has first made a reasonable effort to obtain payment from the customer. The customer shall be given at least forty-eight (48) hours' written notice of termination, but termination of service shall not be made until at least fifteen (15) days after the original bill has been mailed. Service shall not be reestablished until the customer has paid the gas company all amounts due for gas delivered plus a turn-on charge of twenty-five (25) dollars. If the customer has not paid amounts owed, or if the customer has not complied with commission administrative regulations within thirty (30) days from the date the gas is turned off, the gas company may disconnect the customer line from its gathering line. Service shall not be reestablished until the customer has complied with provisions of this administrative regulation pertaining to initial service.

3. A charge of \$150 shall be charged for each new service tap, including saddle and first shutoff valve that Lindsey & Elliott must furnish and install.

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4. A reconnection charge of \$25 shall be paid before service is restored following disconnection of service for nonpayment of bills.

5. A reconnection charge of \$25 shall be paid by customers, which request a disconnection and subsequently re-establish service at the same premises within 12 months.

6. For matters not addressed herein, Lindsey & Elliott adopts the applicable rules of the Public Service Commission.

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
