Nick Benjamin will be available to provide testimony regarding a broad area of issues, including general matters relating to the Project site, planning, design, project schedule, operation, management, mitigation measures, and communications with local officials and members of the public. Mr. Benjamin is the Senior Director of Development with Clearway Energy Group. He has served in energy project development roles for more than 15 years.

Joshua Adams will be available to provide testimony on project permitting, environmental surveys, the traffic study, and other site-specific features, as well as coordination with other agencies. Mr. Adams is a Partner with ERM, a sustainability consulting firm. He received a Bachelor of Science degree in Natural Resource Conservation Management in 2008 from the

University of Kentucky and has more than 15 years' experience in permitting. Mr. Adams has provided services to several renewable-energy projects submitted to the Siting Board.


Jacob Poling will be available to provide testimony regarding the Project's noise analysis studies, including noise generation from construction and operation. Mr. Poling is a Senior Acoustician with Stantec. He received his Bachelor of Arts in Audio Arts and Acoustics with an Acoustics Concentration in 2009 from Columbia College Chicago. He has served as a noise consultant for nearly 15 years.

Dr. Paul Coomes will be available to provide testimony on the economic impact that the Project will have both in the local and regional areas. His report was filed with the application and supplements thereto have been provided in response to data requests. Dr. Coomes has a Ph.D. in Economics, and is a Professor Emeritus of Economics at the University of Louisville, where he started teaching in 1985. Dr. Coomes has provided services to several renewable-energy projects submitted to the Siting Board.

Nick Kirkland will be available to provide testimony on the Kirkland Appraisals property-value report that was filed with the application, as well as respond to questions. Mr. Kirkland is a State Certified General Appraiser in North Carolina, Virginia, and Kentucky. He assisted in the preparation of the Kirkland Appraisals property-value report that was filed with the Song Sparrow application, as well as several other reports filed with the Siting Board.
