Dear Ms. Bridwell:
In accordance with Kentucky-American Water Company's ("KAW") Tariff Sheet No. 49 for KAW's Qualified Infrastructure Program ("QIP"), KAW is required to file a "balancing adjustment" annually to true up QIP estimated costs with actual costs. Enclosed please find the direct testimony of KAW's Jeffrey Newcomb describing the balancing adjustment for QIP Year 3 which was the period July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023.

Exhibit 1 to his testimony shows the calculation for the balancing adjustment and includes supporting documentation describing, on a project-by-project basis, the reasons for differences between estimated and actual costs.

Exhibit 2 to his testimony contains the proposed tariff sheets reflecting the balancing adjustment. Existing Tariff Sheet No. 49 allows for the trued-up amount to be effective 180 days after the end of the QIP period. Since the last day of QIP Year 3 was June 30, 2022, the effective date of the trued-up amount could be December 27, 2022. However, as explained in Mr. Newcomb's testimony, the proposed effective date is February 6, 2024 which coincides with the first date for new base rates in KAW's pending rate case (Case No. 2023-00191).
