
This is in response to the deficiency letter dated October 5, 2023, in the referenced case.

1. The two Statements of Disclosure that were incomplete have been revised and are enclosed.
2. A revised Customer Notice is also enclosed. The revision corrects the change in the amount and the percentage increase from proposed Phase 1 rates to Phase 2 rates for usage of 2,000 gallons. A re-notice to customers should not be required because of the following:
  - a. The error was one cent and was due to rounding in Microsoft Excel.
  - b. The corrected percentage change is 19.74%, rounded to 19.7%. The percentage change using the numbers shown in the original notice was 19.79%, rounded to 19.8%.
  - c. The rounding error resulted in an **overstatement** of both the change in the amount and the percentage increase. Thus, the customers have been given adequate notice of the scope of the increase. There is no harm to the customers since the amount of the increase for the proposed rates is actually less than the amounts shown in the Customer Notice.
  - d. The rounding error was in the Phase 2 rate change. The PSC will require the District to re-advertise the actual Phase 2 rates approved by the Commission before they are implemented.
  - e. Mailing the revised notice to the customers will be an unnecessary expense. The first notice was an insert with the September bills and therefore

there was little added cost. If the District is required to re-notice, it will incur the time and expense of sending a separate mailing to all its customers.
