**NOTICE OF FILING OF 2023 WATER LOSS REPORT AND
IMPLEMENTATION AND PROGRESS OF QIIP**

Comes now the Harrison County Water Association, Inc., by and through their counsel, Mr. Jesse P. Melcher, Esq., attested to by manger, Nathan Fields, and hereby files the yearly water loss report for the year 2023, and the progress on the QIIP filed by HCWA, as follows:


- A. HCWA began collecting water surcharge monies on or about March 1, 2024, for the billing period of January 12, 2024 to February 11, 2024, and has not purchased any of the proposed equipment to implement its proposed QIIP. HCWA has only deposited the receipted surcharge monies from the March billing of \$7,912.19 to date. All future receipted surcharge monies will be added monthly and reported to the KY PSC.
- B) The proposed QIIP implementations are believed to assist on overall yearly reduction of water loss.
- C) The water loss for 2023 is approximately 20.5%, and is in line with the water loss reporting from 2022, which was 20.5%.
- D) HCWA believes that water loss reduction will be realized from implementation of increased acute remediation of water leaks to curb total water loss, and that future acquisition of water leak detection equipment, new meters, and zone detection equipment, if approved by KY PSC, will assist in further reduction of water loss, by location of problem mains and leak areas to address for replacement and/or maintenance.


