**HCWA MOTION WITH NOTICE OF REQUEST  
FOR USE OF SURCHARGE MONIES**

Comes now the Harrison County Water Association, Inc., by and through their counsel, Mr. Jesse P. Melcher, Esq., attested to by manger, Nathan Fields, and hereby files its motion with notice of request to use \$63,341.26, of its accumulated water surcharge monies as reported in this case, as follows:

- A. HCWA as required by Orders of KY PSC, filed a qualified Infrastructure Improvement Plan (QIIP), which established the necessity for future use of Hydro Machine (hydro excavator). Pursuant to Order of This Commission at number 8, page 6 of the Order herein, dated January 11, 2024, HCWA establishes as follows: The Hydro Excavator is a 350 gallon vacuum tank and a water pressure system with a 100 gallon tank, that is on a trailer platform that can be pulled by a truck to the locations; the system allows a pressure stream of water to be injected at the area, to loosen the dirt and debris, and then the vacuum can suck the mud slurry for into the 350 gallon tank for disposal. The Hydro Excavator allows a high pressure water stream to clean out around meter boxes, valves, and other distribution system infrastructure, and to vacuum the slurry away

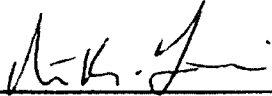
from the area, so that the area can be accessible, maintainable and inspectable.

Therefore, the machine allows HCWA to clean out dirt and debris and create a clean area around the valves and/or areas of system inspection (see. Paragraph 2 of the QIIP, under proposed use of water loss surcharge proceeds). This will allow the distribution system to be exercised for water leak detections, and ensure monitoring areas are accessible for routine detections of possible water leaks.

- B. HCWA purchased a Hydro machine on or about August 19, 2024, in the amount of \$63,341.36, which was paid on September 11, 2024, out of O & M Account (Construction) for HCWA. The estimated cost of the Hydro Excavator with Valve Turner was \$70,000.00, pursuant to the filed QIIP. *See. Attached copy of invoice and paid receipt for the actual cost of \$63,341.36.*
- C. HCWA by its report and filing of collected and billed surcharge monies herein, filed in November, shows collections and deposits of \$69,217.74; currently.
- D. HCWA is requesting by this motion with notice of this request for use of surcharge monies to allow reimbursement of \$63,341.36, from the collected surcharge monies to be paid to HCWA O & M Account for said requested reimbursement expenditure herein.

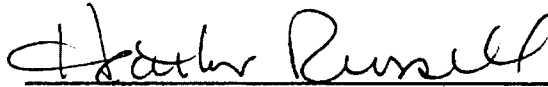
