**FRON bn, LLC’S NOTICE OF INTENT**

Comes now FRON bn, LLC, by and through counsel, pursuant to KRS 278.700, et seq., 807 KAR 5:110, Section 2 and other applicable law, and does hereby tender its Notice of Intent to file an application, on or before December 29, 2023, for a Certificate to Construct an approximately 120 megawatt (“MW”) merchant solar electric generating facility and nonregulated transmission line in Marion and Washington Counties, Kentucky (the “Frontier Solar Project” or “Project”), respectfully stating as follows:

1. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:110, Section 2(2)(a), the forthcoming application will be filed by FRON bn, LLC, 13123 E Emerald Coast Parkway, Inlet Beach, FL 32461. The applicant’s telephone number is: (859) 380-7781 and its email address is: joseph.albrecht@brightnightpower.com.

2. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:110, Section 2(2)(b), the Project will be capable of generating approximately 120 MW of electricity from a solar array covering a total of approximately 1,020 acres. The Project will connect to a substation to be constructed onsite. The substation will

interconnect to a utility-owned transmission line via a nonregulated transmission line to be constructed entirely within the Project footprint.

3. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:110, Section 2(2)(c), the Frontier Solar Project is located in unincorporated Marion and Washington Counties, Kentucky, near the City of Lebanon. The Project has a street address of 3776 Springfield Highway, Lebanon, Kentucky 40033.

4. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:110, Section 2(2)(d), there is no planning or zoning commission with jurisdiction over the site.

5. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:110, Section 2(2)(e), there are no local setback requirements applicable to this site.

6. Pursuant to KRS 278.704(4), the applicant will request a deviation from the setback requirements found in KRS 278.704(2).
