Junior Quarterback Jarrett Stewart had four pass completions, out of nine attempts, for a total of 98 passing yards, including one touchdown, and had five rushing yards for a total of 6 yards.

Kellen Marksbury led

the team in points with 12, with one rushing, and one receiving touchdowns. The Senior had 60 rushing yards in six attempts, 90 receiving yards with three receptions, one interception, and three total tackles, two solo, and one assisted.

Senior Kyle Brentzel scored five points with a field goal and a perfect two-for-two on extra

point attempts. Sophomore Brody Phelps had 57 rushing yards in eight attempts, one fumble recovery, and had five total tackles, two solo, and three assisted.

Senior Kenna Carnes had 4 rushing yards in

two attempts, and five assisted tackles. Senior Arick Henry had one pass reception for eight yards, and one solo tackle.

Senior Tanner Shular had 10 total tackles, three solo, and seven assisted.

Junior Ian Blanford had six total tackles, one solo, and five assisted.

Sophomore Wyatt Lockard had one forced defensive fumble, and five total tackles, one solo, and four assisted.

Junior Jacob Biller had five total tackles, one solo, and four assisted, and had one defensive sack.

Sophomore Paxton Truitt had four total tackles, three solo, and one assisted.

Junior John Winstead had three assisted tackles.

Senior Jacob Blinnett had two assisted tackles. As a team, the Bears

finished the game with 137 rushing yards, allowing 193 rushing yards to the Cardinals. Both teams were also closely matched in the passing game, with Spencer completing 98 yards, with Nelson having 84 yards gained.

The Bears finished their regular season with an overall record of 5-5, 4-3 in the class, and 3-2 in the district.

The Bears play again at home on Friday against the 3-6 Western Warriors in the first round of the Class 4A UK HealthCare Sports Medicine State Football Finals.
