#### GARRISON-QUINCY-KY-O-HEIGHTS WATER DISTRICT ADDITIONAL CUSTOMER NOTICE

On December 19, 2023, the Kentucky Public Service Commission (PSC) accepted for filing Garrison-Quincy-Ky-O-Heights Water District's (Garrison-Quincy-Ky-O-Heights District) application requesting to increase its revenue from water sales by \$141,239, an approximate increase of 31.59 percent. On April 30, 2024, Commission Staff determined Garrison-Quincy-Ky-O-Heights District would require an increase of \$186,259 or 41.66 percent in revenue from water sales.

Not including the water loss surcharge, the proposed rates will increase a typical residential customer's monthly water bill, using 3,000 gallons, from \$32.20 to \$45.63, an increase of \$13.43, or approximately 41.70 percent. Although the Commission Staff did not recommend a change to the surcharge, the increase with the \$1.73 water loss surcharge will result in the average customer using 3,000 gallons increasing from \$32.20 to \$47.36, an increase of \$15.16, or approximately 47.08 percent.

Garrison-Quincy-Ky-O-Heights District requests the PSC approve its recommended revenue requirements and that Garrison-Quincy-Ky-O-Heights District be allowed to implement the revised rates as follows:


