AT&T Kentucky respectfully provides this response to the Commission's December 14, 2023, order in this docket requesting parties to this proceeding and all other interested persons to file a short list of issues to be discussed at the January 5, 2024, informal conference regarding Commission regulation 807 KAR 5:015.

AT&T has not yet identified any specific list of pole attachment issues, regarding the extension of broadband services, that might be addressed through changes in the regulations, rules, or tariffs governing pole attachments. However, given the importance of extending broadband services throughout the Commonwealth, as appreciated by the Commission, and the extensive work recently completed in amending Commission pole attachment regulation 807 KAR 5:015—which became effective just last year, February 1, 2022--AT&T respectfully requests that the Commission utilize this proceeding, at this juncture, primarily to make certain that all industry members and stakeholders are fully educated regarding proper application of the new regulation; and to ensure that all parties are currently compliant, before looking more broadly at proposing changes in the regulations, rules, or tariffs governing pole attachments.
