MOTION TO BE RELIEVED OF REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

Comes now East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. (“EKPC”), by and through counsel, pursuant to the May 27, 2025 Order of the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“Commission”) and other applicable law, and for its Motion to Be Relieved Of Reporting Requirements, respectfully states as follows:

1. On December 14, 2023, the Commission opened this investigation to, “...create a stakeholder process to discuss and investigate issues and lessons learned relating to pole attachments.”¹ The Commission held an Informal Conferences with the parties on January 5, 2024, February 9, 2024, March 1, 2024, March 22, 2024, April 26, 2024, May 17, 2024, and October 11, 2024. Throughout the proceedings the parties submitted comments and revisions on the Commission’s proposed emergency regulations regarding pole attachments.

2. On May 27, 2025, the Commission issued an order requiring the parties to file a report on the 15th of each third month following the order that contains the number of pole-

attachment requests received; processing time for the request; whether make-ready is required; the time to complete make-ready; and the number of attachment requests competed in the quarter.²

3. Since June 15, 2025, EKPC has been filing the required quarterly reports. Since its first quarterly report on June 15, 2025, EKPC has had no substantive quarterly report. This is due to EKPC's status as a generation and transmission electric cooperative and the fact pole attachers do not connect transmission structures.

4. Since no attacher has ever requested to attach to an EKPC structure, EKPC is now asking to be permitted to be relieved from this reporting requirement. If during a quarter, EKPC ever receives a request to attach to one of its structures EKPC will file a quarterly report.

5. EKPC does not believe this will prejudice the Commission, or any other party to this proceeding, or obstruct the Commission's quarterly report to the Legislative Research Commission for referral to the Interim Joint Committee on Natural Resources and Energy.

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, EKPC respectfully moves the Commission to permit it to be relieved from the quarterly report filings in this proceeding.
