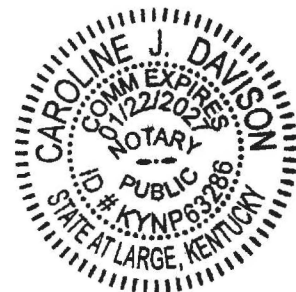

**Question No. 3.1**

**Responding Witness: Lonnie E. Bellar / Charles R. Schram**

- Q-3.1. Please refer to the Companies' response to Staff's Request No. 1-19(b) and Joint Intervenors' cross-examination of the Companies' Witness Bellar, from approximately 12:18 p.m. to 12:21 p.m. State whether the third-party reliability assessment report completed by Texas Gas Transmission referenced in Attachment 2 has been received by the Company. If so, please provide a copy of the report. If not, please explain why not and identify by when you anticipate receiving a copy of the report.
- A-3.1. No, the Companies have not received the referenced report and the Companies do not anticipate receiving it. Texas Gas Transmission ("TGT") has indicated that the report contains significant content beyond weather preparation information that is proprietary to TGT and that will not be provided outside of TGT. Having said that, the Companies note that information concerning the weather preparation upgrades TGT made as a result of the storm event to better serve the Companies has been provided in the record of this case. See the response to PSC 1-19.

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**Question No. 3.2**

**Responding Witness: Lonnie E. Bellar**

- Q-3.2. Please refer to Joint Intervenors' cross-examination of the Companies' Witness Bellar, from approximately 11:40am to 11:41am. Please identify and produce any estimate or enumeration of the cost of the on-site compression being planned for Mill Creek 5.
- A-3.2. The Companies' EPC contractor has indicated that onsite compression is approximately \$7 million of the overall EPC contract cost for Mill Creek 5.
