NOTICE

Comes now Kentucky Frontier Gas, LLC (“Kentucky Frontier”) by and through the undersigned counsel, and does hereby state as follows for its Notice pursuant to KRS 278.190(2) and the Commission’s January 30, 2024 Order in this matter and Kentucky Frontier respectfully states as follows:

1. The Commission deemed Kentucky Frontier’s revised Purchased Gas Cost Adjustment Tariff that changes the calculation methodology of its Gas Cost Recovery (GCR) rate accepted for filing as of June 5, 2023 in Case No. 2023-00067.

2. In Case No. 2023-00067, the Commission suspended Kentucky Frontier’s effective date of the proposed tariff for five months, up to and including December 5, 2023 pursuant to KRS 278.190(2).

3. In Case No. 2023-00067, pursuant to KRS 278.190(2), the proceeding had not concluded nor an order made to date, therefore, Kentucky Frontier gave its Notice to put its proposed tariff into effect as of December 28, 2023, and Kentucky Frontier stated that it would maintain its records in a manner as will enable it, its customers, or the Commission, to determine the amounts to be refunded and to whom, in the event a refund is awarded.

4. On December 29, 2023, Kentucky Frontier filed its Purchased Gas Adjustment Application, and excel spreadsheet as supporting documents for reference in the above-styled case, explaining that Notice was provided in Case No. 2023-00067 on December 28, 2023, pursuant to KRS 278.190(2) that the proposed Gas Balancing Adjustment method will be put into effect subject to refund, therefore the Purchased Gas Adjustment Application utilizes the proposed Gas Balancing Adjustment method put into effect via the tariff made effective through Case No. 2023-00067. Multiple supportive and descriptive filings have been made in Case No. 2023-00067 and can be referenced should any further explanation be required regarding the method applied.

5. On January 30, 2024, the Commission entered its Order suspending the proposed Purchase Gas Adjustment/Gas Cost Recovery (“PGA/GCR”) for one day, until February 2, 2024 and stating that “Kentucky Frontier’s proposed GCR rates may be placed in effect by Kentucky Frontier on or after February 2, 2024, pending the final Order in this matter and subject to refund, provided Kentucky Frontier files written notice to the Commission of its intention to do so as required by KRS 278.190(2).” Therefore, in addition to the Notice given and referred to in the application filed on December 29, 2023, Kentucky Frontier gives additional Notice that it has put the proposed tariff filed in Case No. 2023-00067 and used to calculate the PGA/GCR rates in this proceeding, into effect and the rates proposed by Kentucky Frontier in this proceeding and suspended by the Commission until February 2, 2024, herein shall be in effect, subject to refund, with service rendered on or after February 2, 2024, to be billed in March 2024.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing, Kentucky Frontier gives the Commission notice of the tariff filing that was effective December 28, 2023, and additional notice requested by the Commission’s January 30, 2024 Order in this matter.
