REQUEST 1

RESPONSIBLE PARTY: John Coffey, Acting General Manager

Request 1. Provide the name of all utilities and municipal water providers to which Morgan County Water District provides wholesale water.

Response 1. Morgan District provides wholesale water service to the city of Campton and emergency wholesale water service to the city of Frenchburg.

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REQUEST 2

RESPONSIBLE PARTY: John Coffey, Acting General Manager

Request 2. State whether each utility and municipal water provider is billed under the 4-inch wholesale rate. If the utility or municipal water provider is not billed under the 4-inch wholesale rate, provide the rate each wholesale customer is billed.

Response 2: Currently the only water customers that are billed under the 4-Inch meter (wholesale) rate are the cities of Campton (Wholesale Customer) and Frenchburg (Emergency Wholesale Customer).

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REQUEST 3

RESPONSIBLE PARTY: John Coffey, Acting General Manager

Request 3. Confirm that Morgan District provided notice to the city of Campton and the city of Frenchburg of the proposed wholesale rate increase.

Response 3: Morgan District confirms that the cities of Compton and Frenchburg received proper notification of the increase in the wholesale water rate. Morgan District published customer notification once a week for three (3) consecutive as required by 807 KAR 5:0076. In reviewing 807 KAR 5:076, Morgan District did not find a requirement that its wholesale customers should receive written notification. Below is the rate schedule contained in the published customer notice.
