## To Whom It May Concern:

On March 1, 2024, Mantle Rock Solar, LLC ("Mantle Rock") submitted for filing its original Notice of Intent to file and was assigned Case No. 2024-00050. Now, Mantle Rock hereby submits for filing this Second Renewed and Restated Notice of Intent to file an application for a Certificate of Construction for an approximately 65 MW solar facility ("Mantle Rock Project"). The only information that has changed since the original Notice of Intent is the email address for the point of contact in paragraph (a) below is different.

b. The proposed construction is briefly described as follows:

The facility will consist of approximately 562 acres of solar panels and associated racking (approximately 65 MW), inverters, battery storage, and a project substation.



- c. The proposed Mantle Rock Project will be located in the vicinity of the intersection of Maxfield and Carrsville Road. The latitude and longitude are 36°31'51.47"N, 88°23'24.85"W. The Mantle Rock Project is not located within the limits of any city.
- d. There is no planning or zoning commission with jurisdiction over the site.
- e. Because there is no planning or zoning commission with jurisdiction over the site, there are no local setbacks set forth by County ordinance.
- f. There are no residential neighborhoods, schools, hospitals, or nursing home facilities within 2,000 feet of the Mantle Rock Project, and therefore, the applicant will not need to request a deviation from the setback requirements found in KRS 278.704(2).
