

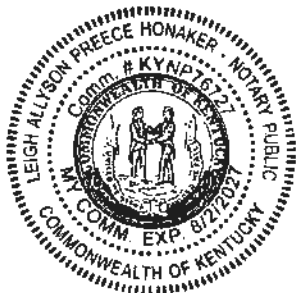

December 9, 2024 Update: During the pendency of these proceedings there have been two changes to the revenue requirement that was presented in the Application, Exhibit 10, Wolfram Direct Testimony, Exhibit JW-2. The first is a large commercial customer is terminating service as of February 1, 2025. This will result in a revenue loss of \$238,485 per year. A copy of the termination letter is filed in redacted form and is the subject of a motion for confidential treatment. Additionally, a new labor contract has been negotiated while this proceeding has been ongoing. Please see the Updated Response to Commission Staff's First Request, Item 24 for additional details. Please see the Excel spreadsheets provide separately for how these changes impact the revenue requirement.
