Dear Ms. Bridwell:

On August 11, 2026, the Commission directed Columbia Gas of Kentucky, Inc. ("Columbia") to file on the public docket certain documents for which confidential treatment had been denied.

One such document, Columbia's response to Staff's Post-Hearing Request, Item 5, Attachment A, exceeds seven hundred pages. The Commission granted confidential treatment in part and has permitted Columbia to redact "material" information from Attachment A. To ensure Columbia properly identifies and redacts the "material" information that the Commission defined to be "lease amounts; escalation of lease payments; remedies available to the parties for nonperformance of the terms; any other economic terms; the structure of the lease term including the outside date for the rent commencement date; and any other specifically negotiated terms," requires time-intensive efforts to coordinate with the appropriate subject matter experts and counsel to confirm that all "material" terms have been redacted from Attachment A. As such, Columbia respectfully posits that it will need approximately one additional week to file the redacted version of Item 5, Attachment A. The Company is also willing to file a motion to formally request this extension if that is the desire of this Commission; however, in the interests of administrative efficiency, the Company will proceed forward with the redactions and an intended filing in a week's time without burdening the Commission with another motion to consider. The remainder of the requested documents are being filed contemporaneously with this letter.
