<u>RESPONSE</u>: Please see Columbia Gas Attachment RJA-2, page 33 (attached for ease of reference). Columbia's COSS indicates that there are zero commodity costs associated with service to the DS/IS rate schedule. Since, as discussed on pages 4-5 of Mr. Murray's Direct Testimony, the DS tail block is intended to recover commodity/volumetric costs, it is inappropriate to increase the tail block in this proceeding. Therefore, Mr. Murray is proposing to leave the tail block at its current level and to recover any increase to the DS schedule through customer charges and the first two tiers of the energy blocks.
