Comes now East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. (“EKPC”), by and through counsel, and hereby gives notice that it is withdrawing the August 14, 2024 Motion which requested the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“Commission”) schedule a hearing in this case. Respectfully, EKPC states as follows:


1. On April 19, 2024, the Commission issued an order establishing this proceeding and set a procedural schedule. The Procedural Schedule required EKPC to request a hearing on or before August 14, 2024. On August 14, 2024, EKPC filed a motion requesting an Informal Conference and requested the Commission schedule a hearing.
2. The Commission granted the request for an Informal Conference,¹ which was held on August 27, 2024. The Informal Conference was attended by Commission Staff and representatives from EKPC.
3. Based upon the constructive discussion at the Informal Conference, EKPC no longer believes a hearing is necessary in this case.


