APPLICANT PIKE COUNTY SOLAR PROJECT, LLC'S MOTION TO RESCHEDULE FORMAL HEARING

Comes now Applicant Pike County Solar Project, LLC (the "Project") by and through counsel and for good cause, and respectfully moves the Kentucky Electric Generation and Transmission Siting Board ("Board") to reschedule the formal hearing relative to the Project's Application, which is currently scheduled for October 3, 2024.

The reason for this request is that the Project's key witnesses, Jeannine Johnson and Erich Miarka of Savion, LLC, are both in areas of North Carolina that were severely affected by the catastrophic damage and flooding beginning last Friday and continuing to the present from Hurricane Helene. Specifically, roads in and out of the area are indefinitely closed, and these witnesses are without internet or electric, and even cellular service is intermittent. They are also dealing with the effects of the storm in their families and community, making preparation and travel this week impossible.

The Project therefore respectfully requests that the Board reschedule the formal hearing for another date that is at least a week beyond October 3, 2024, to allow time for roads to hopefully become passable and electric/internet to be restored.

As an alternative date, the Project notes that another formal hearing (on the Lynn Bark Energy Center application, Case No. 2024-00104) is scheduled for October 16, 2024 and involves the same witnesses as this Project. It would therefore be efficient for these two hearings to proceed on October 16 if that is possible for the Board and other stakeholders.

The Project will publish public notice of the new formal hearing date as soon as possible once it is set by the Board.
