**LOUISVILLE GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY'S**  
**MOTION TO SUBMIT CASE FOR DECISION ON RECORD**

In response to the Kentucky Public Service Commission’s (“Commission”) April 30, 2024 Order, directing that “LG&E [Louisville Gas and Electric Company] or any Intervenor shall request either a hearing or that the case be submitted for decision based on the record no later than ... 08/14/2024,” LG&E hereby moves the Commission to issue an order deciding the issues in this proceeding based upon the record because the record in this case is sufficient for the Commission to issue a final order without an evidentiary hearing.

There has been ample discovery and testimony in this proceeding, which began not with an application, but rather a tariff filing that proposes revisions to LG&E’s Local Gas Delivery Service (“LGDS”) tariff. Since the Commission opened this proceeding, the Commission Staff has propounded, and LG&E has responded to, three sets of data requests. Intervenor Louisville Metropolitan Sewer District (“MSD”) submitted two sets of data requests to LG&E that have been answered. In addition, MSD responded to a set of data requests each from Commission Staff and LG&E.

Moreover, both MSD and LG&E have filed testimony regarding the proposed revisions to the LGDS tariff. Thus, particularly given the narrow scope of this proceeding, the factual record is complete and sufficient for the Commission to consider and weigh the evidence and issue an

order without requiring a hearing. Should the Commission find that an evidentiary hearing or briefing would assist the Commission in considering the relevant issues, LG&E will fully participate.

WHEREFORE, Louisville Gas and Electric Company respectfully moves the Commission to issue an order declining to hold an evidentiary hearing in this proceeding and deciding the issues on the record.
