MOTION FOR CLARIFICATION

Comes now East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc., (“EKPC” or the Company”) by and through the undersigned counsel and hereby requests the Commission clarify the procedural dates in this case.

1. On April 26, 2024, EKPC submitted an Application for two Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity (“CPCN”) to construct two solar facilities, Site Compatibility Certificates (“Certificates”) and the approval to assume leases associated with one of the solar facilities. On May 14, 2024, the Commission entered an Order establishing June 12, 2024, as the date EKPC was to file responses to Commission Staff’s First Request for Information (“Staff’s First Request”).


2. On May 30, 2024, Staff's First Request was issued and it states EKPC must file responses to Staff's First Request on June 5, 2024, six (6) days after the request was issued.

3. EKPC is requesting the Commission clarify that the responses are due June 12, 2024 and not June 5, 2024.

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, EKPC respectfully requests the Commission confirm the responses to Staff's First Request are due on June 12, 2024.


