EKPC respectfully states as follows:

1. The Commission issued its Order establishing this case on August 2, 2024, and included dates for requests for information, intervenor testimony, rebuttal testimony, and a date to request a hearing or submit on the record.
2. No parties requested intervention in these proceedings, the dates for requests for information has passed, and EKPC will not be filing any written testimony in this matter.
3. EKPC believes the responses to the requests for information address any issues presented in this matter. Accordingly, EKPC does not believe that a formal evidentiary hearing is necessary in this case and moves to submit the case for an adjudication based upon the existing administrative record without a formal evidentiary hearing.
