

## NOTICE

The Shelbyville Municipal Water & Sewer Commission (SMW&SC) Is providing notice that on February 15, 2021 a proposed increase in water rates was approved by the Commission, including wholesale water rates to Water Districts, and recommended these changes to the City Council which had their 1<sup>st</sup> reading on March 4, 2021, with the 2<sup>nd</sup> was held on March 18, 2021. This ordinance allowed the Commission to do annual increases of 2.5% annually to all water and sewer customers. The SMW&SC filed the revised rates it is proposing to charge West Shelby Water District (**Finchville Master Meter**) with the Public Service Commission on April 10, 2024. These rates will be effective for water service rendered on and after June 19, 2024. The proposed rates are as follows:

Quantities over the respective Contract Limits shall be charged the PROPOSED Rate described above, plus \$1.00 per 1,000 gallons.

Water flowing through the meter(s) before the effective date will be charged at the current rates while water is flowing through the meter(s) on and after the effective date (July 19, 2023) will be charged at the proposed rates.
