Memphis edges WVU in bowl game

FRISCO, Texas (AP) — Seth Henigan threw for 294 yards and two touchdowns in his final game for No. 25 Memphis, matching the American Athletic Conference career TD passing record with 104, as the Tigers held on to beat West Virginia 42-37 in the Frisco Bowl on Tuesday.

Memphis (11-2) reached 11 wins for only the second time in its 109 years of football, and improved to 4-0 in bowl games under fifth-year coach Ryan Silverfield. WVU had scored on six consecutive possessions (four TDs) before one more chance in the final minute.

On May 22, 2024, the Kentucky Public Service Commission (PSC) accepted for filing Cannonsburg Water District's (Cannonsburg District) application requesting to increase its revenue from water sales by \$397,464, an approximate increase of 15.88 percent. On October 17, 2024, Commission Staff determined Cannonsburg District would require an increase of \$484,805 or 19.37 percent in revenue from water sales. On December 17, 2024, the Commission Staff issued a correction to the volumetric rates for the 3/4-Inch x 5/8-Inch Meter and the 1-Inch Meter Sizes, Cannonsburg District requests the PSC approve its recommended revenue requirements and that Cannonsburg District be allowed to implement the revised rates as follows:
