RE: Formal Application to Increase Rates Pursuant to Purchased Water Adjustment Regulation 807 KAR 5:068

Dear Ms. Bridwell:

The U.S. 60 Water District respectfully requests that the Commission allow for an adjustment to our rates in accordance with 807 KAR 5:068 Purchased Water Adjustment clause.

The District was recently notified by its supplier, the Shelbyville Municipal Water & Sewer Commission, that it would increase its wholesale rates by \$0.06 per 1000 gallons. This increase will take effect on May 19, 2024. The result of this increase is \$10,871.04 in additional annual supply cost for the District. This translates into \$0.08 per 1000 gallons of water sold to our customers. Therefore, we propose to increase our rates by that amount.

NOTICE

The Shelbyville Municipal Water & Sewer Commission (SMW&SC) Is providing notice that on February 15, 2021 a proposed increase in water rates was approved by the Commission, including wholesale water rates to Water Districts, and recommended these changes to the City Council which had their 1st reading on March 4, 2021, with the 2nd reading scheduled for March 18, 2021. This ordinance allowed the Commission to do annual increases of 2.5% annually to all water and sewer customers. The SMW&SC filed the revised wholesale rates it is proposing to charge North Shelby Water Company and US 60 Water District with Public Service Commission on April 10, 2024. These rates will be effective for water service rendered on and after May 19, 2024. The proposed rates are as follows:

Quantities over the respective Contract Limits shall be charged the PROPOSED Rate described above, plus \$1.00 per 1,000 gallons.

The Shelbyville City Council had the 1st hearing on March 4,2021 and the 2nd hearing will be on March 18, 2021. Water flowing through the meter(s) before the effective date will be charged at the current rates while water is flowing through the meter(s) on and after the effective date (May 19, 2024) will be charged at the proposed rates.

This filing may be examined at the Offices of SMW&SC located at 1059 Washington St. in Shelbyville, KY.

This filing may also be examined at the Offices of the Public Service Commission located at 211 Sower Boulevard in Frankfort Kentucky, Monday-Friday from 8:00 am -4:30 pm or on the PSC website at <u>http://psc.ky.gov</u>.

The Rates contained in this NOTICE are the rates proposed by the "SMW&SC", however the PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION may order rates that differ from the proposed rates.

Intervention may be requested by submitting a timely written request for intervention by mail to the Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 615, Frankfort, KY 40602. The request for intervention must establish the grounds for the request including the status and interest of the party.

If the Public Service Commission does not receive a written request for intervention within thirty (30) days of the providing of this notice, the Public Service Commission may take final action on the filing.

Notice is hereby given that because of an increase in the cost of water purchased from the Shelbyville Municipal Water & Sewer Commission, the U.S. 60 Water District will increase its rates for services effective June 1, 2024. An application requesting the proposed rates was filed with the Kentucky Public Service Commission on May 22, 2024 to increase rates as follows:

As noted above, based on the increased cost of water from the Shelbyville Municipal Water & Sewer Commission, all rates will increase \$0.08 per 1,000 gallons. The monthly bill for a typical residential customer using an average of 4,485 gallons of water each month will increase from \$51.09 to \$51.45. This is an increase of \$0.36 or 0.71%.

The charges/rates contained in this notice are the charges/rates proposed by the U.S. 60 Water District. However, the Public Service Commission may order charges/rates to be charged that differ from these proposed charges/rates. Such action may result in charges/rates for consumers other than the charges/rates detailed in this notice.
