ATMOS ENERGY CORPORATION'S
MOTION TO SUBMIT

Comes now Atmos Energy Corporation (“Atmos Energy”), by and through counsel, pursuant to KRS 61.878, 807 KAR 5:001, Section 13 and other applicable law, and requests that the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“Commission”) allow Atmos Energy to withdraw its request for an Informal Conference and formal hearing and instead allow this matter to be decided on the administrative record. Respectfully, Atmos Energy states as follows:

1. On September 27, 2024, the Commission issued an Order establishing a procedural schedule for the processing of this matter. The September 27, 2024 Order established multiple discovery dates¹ and a date for any party in the case to request the case be submitted for a decision on the record.

2. On December 17, 2024, Atmos Energy requested an Informal Conference with Commission Staff or for the Commission to schedule a formal hearing.

3. After further consideration, Atmos Energy believes that the issues presented in this case are straightforward and have been adequately addressed through written discovery. Accordingly, Atmos Energy does not believe that an Informal Conference or formal evidentiary

hearing is necessary. Atmos Energy believes that a formal hearing would not assist the Commission in developing the administrative record in any meaningful way.

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, Atmos Energy respectfully requests the Commission allow it to withdraw the Motion for Informal Conference and Hearing that was filed on December 17, 2024, and request a decision based upon the existing administrative record.
