
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

Request 1: What is the Company's policy regarding the amount of arrearages that can be accrued by a customer before service is disconnected?

Response 1: Licking Valley does not terminate service based upon the amount of arrearages. Licking Valley disconnects service pursuant to its tariffs on file with the Commission, in particular Second Revised Sheet 14 – Second Revised Sheet 22. Licking Valley also follows the disconnection regulations in 807 KAR 5:006.

Response 3: As of February 20, 2025, there are 559 customers that owe a total of \$139,636.96.

Request 4: How many ratepayers owe an arrearage in excess of \$2,000?

Response 4: Two customers.

Response 5: One residential member.

Request 6: For each customer who owes an arrearage more than \$2,000, identify the customer and describe how the Company allowed the ratepayer to accrue an arrearage to that degree?

Request 6: An account was found with a meter that was bypassed. The member claimed he was paying for electric through his lease. The lease agreement was reviewed by Licking Valley. Licking Valley then connected the member with a new meter and used average usage to bill his past usage of 13 months, as permitted by 807 KAR 5:006.
