**RESOLUTION EC24-33**

**FISCAL YEAR 2024  
AUTHORIZING RESOLUTION  
COUNTY OF Edmonson**

**A RESOLUTION ACKNOWLEDGING AND RATIFYING THE FISCAL COURT VOTE ON MAY 25, 1999, TO INCREASE THE WATER COMMISSIONERS' RATE OF PAY TO \$6,000 PER YEAR, WITH A REQUIREMENT OF SIX HOURS OF WATER DISTRICT MANAGEMENT TRAINING APPROVED BY THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION**

**WHEREAS**, on May 25, 1999, the Fiscal Court unanimously voted to increase the annual rate of pay for Water Commissioners to \$3,600 per year without training hours, and \$6,000 per year after completing the required training as outlined in KRS 74.020 Section 6: and

**WHEREAS**, although the increase was voted on and unanimously approved by the Edmonson County Fiscal Court on May 25, 1999, and consequently put in effect by the Water District Board of Commissioners, the specific amount of the increase was left out of the public record on the corresponding minutes of the Fiscal Court proceedings.

**WHEREAS**, in conjunction with this adjustment, it was required that all Water Commissioners complete six hours of water district management training, approved by the Public Service Commission, to ensure that they are equipped with the necessary skills and knowledge to effectively serve the community and to receive the maximum \$6,000 per year salary.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Edmonson County Fiscal Court, that we acknowledge and ratify the decision made on May 25, 1999, to specifically reflect the increased salary parameters set forth by 20 RS HB 446/HCS 1 that officially became part of KRS 74.020 and was passed by the Kentucky Legislature to take effect on January 1, 1999.
