Comes now the Bracken County Water District, ("BCWD") by and through the chairman of the board of commissioners, Mr. Philip Crawford, and the manager, Mr. Derrick Bach, and through counsel, Mr. Jesse P. RESPONSE/ANSWER: It is believed the FCV is the construction and development costs, total \$327,419.20; however, since the project costs were not borne by BCWD, said asset is a contribution asset, and the costs of construction and engineering will be the fair cash value of the contributed asset.

ABBIA only developed this line to provide a water line into the Industrial park and did not intend to carry the water assets on its books as the project is partially funded by a grant and ABBIA is not in the business and has not provided water.

BCWD is simply receipting, if approved, by KY PSC, the assets and only intends to carry the asset as contribution in the amount contributed/expended by the giftor; See answer to Number # 5.

Yes. DOW approved the line on or about March 7, 2024; see attached approval report. See Exhibit "B", attached hereto and fully incorporated herein. Bluegrass Engineering oversaw the construction and inspection of the job. See Exhibit "C" (consisting of 14 pages), attached hereto and fully incorporated herein.
