



**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 22-13 ESTABLISHING

Whereas, the City of Campbellsville through the Campbellsville Water & Sewer System provide water to persons residing within the corporate boundaries of the City of Campbellsville and to persons residing in Taylor County, Kentucky, but outside the corporate boundaries of the City of Campbellsville; and

Whereas, the City of Campbellsville desires and intends to provide water and sewer services to the residents of the City of Campbellsville and Taylor County, Kentucky in such a way as to cover its costs, but not to seek a profit; and

Whereas, the cost of operating the Campbellsville Water & Sewer System has increased over time and the infrastructure owned by the Campbellsville Water & Sewer System is in need of repairs and improvements and will need repairs and improvements in the future; and

Whereas, revenues generated from the operations of the Campbellsville Water & Sewer System at the existing rates are inadequate to cover the costs associated with continued operations, repairs and improvements to the system; and

Whereas, the Campbellsville Water & Sewer System has a written contract for providing water to the Lebanon Water Works which involved the construction of certain infrastructure to accommodate the Lebanon Water Works's need for water now and in the future. The rate charged to the Lebanon Water Works is governed by the terms and conditions of the written contract and this Ordinance does not govern the rates charged or to be charged to Lebanon Water Works

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Campbellsville intends to raise rates for certain wholesale water customers so as to cover the increased costs of operation which the Campbellsville Water & Sewer System have incurred and are incurring.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMPBELLSVILLE, KENTUCKY as follows:**

1. Water Rates for Wholesale Customers. Beginning on August 1, 2024, water rates for the following wholesale customers shall be as follows:

**ORDINANCE NUMBER: 2024-01**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RUSSELL SPRINGS, KENTUCKY APPROVING AN INCREASE IN THE WATER RATES THE CITY OF RUSSELL SPRINGS CHARGES ITS CUSTOMERS TO OFFSET THE CITY OF JAMESTOWN, KENTUCKY WHOLESALE RATE INCREASE**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Russell Springs, Russell County, Kentucky (“Russell Springs”) owns and operates a municipal water distribution system;

**WHEREAS**, the City of Jamestown, Russell County, Kentucky (“Jamestown”) sells water on a wholesale basis to Russell Springs;

**WHEREAS**, Jamestown has increased the wholesale rate it charges Russell Springs by approximately 31.5%;

**WHEREAS**, based upon the water purchases from Jamestown during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023, the estimated annual increased cost to Russell Springs is approximately **\$264,529**;

**WHEREAS**, prudent financial management dictates that Russell Springs take immediate action by enacting an Ordinance adjusting its retail and wholesale water rates commensurate with Jamestown’s wholesale rate increase; and

**WHEREAS**, Russell Springs intends to increase its water rates commensurate with Jamestown’s wholesale rate increase via a Purchased Water Adjustment whereby each rate tier will be increased by a uniform amount per 1,000 gallons.



**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RUSSELL SPRINGS, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1. Incorporation of Preamble.** The facts, recitals, and statements contained in the foregoing preamble of this Ordinance are true and correct and are hereby affirmed and incorporated as part of this Ordinance.

**Section 2. Purchased Water Adjustment Factor.** The Purchased Water Adjustment Factor is **\$0.87** per 1,000 gallons.

**Section 3. New Retail Water Rates.** The schedule of retail rates for water service furnished by the Russell Springs water system is hereby established as provided in **Appendix A**.

**Section 4. Minimum Retail Rates.** The minimum monthly water rate for retail customers residing within the corporate limits of Russell Springs shall be \$17.41 for the first 2,000 gallons of water, and the minimum monthly water rate for retail customers residing outside the corporate limits of Russell Springs shall be \$28.97 for the first 2,000 gallons of water.

**Section 5. New Water Wholesale Rate by Contract.** The wholesale rate for East Casey County Water District, Western Pulaski Water District, and Columbia/Adair Utility District shall be **\$3.85** per 1,000 gallons. The wholesale water rate set forth in this Ordinance is contingent upon approval by the Kentucky

Public Service Commission and shall not take effect until this approval has been obtained.

**Section 6. Annual CPI Adjustment.** Nothing contained in this Ordinance shall affect the provisions of Ordinance No. 2019-05 enacted by Russell Springs on November 22, 2019. Ordinance No. 2019-05 provides for an automatic, annual adjustment of retail water rates in accordance with the Consumer Price Index for Urban Wage Earners and Clerical Workers (“CPI-W”). The CPI-W is the same cost-of-living adjustment used by the Social Security Administration.

**Section 7. Other Water Fees & Charges.** All other existing fees and charges and rules and regulations concerning dates for paying water bills, late payment fees, disconnection charges, reconnection fees, tap fees, charges for water deposits, and any and all other fees pertaining to water service not specifically repealed or revised by this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

**Section 8. Conflicts Repealed.** All ordinances, resolutions, or orders, or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed. This Ordinance shall be effective upon its adoption and the publication of a Summary thereof as required by law.





The proposed rate increase of \$0.25/1,000 gallons will compensate for the higher wholesale purchase water rates proposed by the City of Campbellsville and City of Russell Springs. The proposed wholesale rate increase of \$0.87/1,000 gallons will compensate for the higher wholesale purchase water rate proposed by the City of Russell Springs.
