
Dear Ms. Bridwell:

Please find attached for electronic filing with the Commission, East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc.'s ("EKPC") Supplemental Responses to Commission Staff and the Joint Intervenor's Requests for Information. In addition, please find an updated Figure 3 and Attachment JJT-3 from the Direct Testimony of Julia J. Tucker. Figure 3 and JJT-3 was updated after a minor error was found in the Summer ELCC values. The summer capacity was previously understated by 30 MW and has been corrected. In addition, the timing for additional generation after the Liberty RICE plant, has been updated to be consistent with information filed in Case No. 2024-00370. These updates do not create a change in EKPC's need for the generation being requested in this Application, nor do they modify any of the supporting analyses. EKPC is also filing a Motion for Confidential Treatment for Supplemental Response JI 3-9.

This is to certify that the electronic filing was made on March 10, 2025, and there are no parties the Commission has excused from electronic filing procedures. Pursuant to the Commission's July 22, 2021 Order in Case No. 2020-00085, no paper copies of this filing are being made.
