East Kentucky Power Cooperative (EKPC) plans to establish Liberty Station, a new 214-megawatt electric-generating station fueled by natural gas at a 100-acre site in Casey County, approximately four miles north of Liberty, Ky. The new facility is expected to be in operation by late 2028 and will create 23 new full-time jobs.

You are being contacted because records on file with the local property valuation administrator's office indicate you own property in the vicinity of the planned Liberty Station. EKPC would like to share more information about its plans, and provide an opportunity for you to learn more.
