1. Refer to the document filed June 15, 2026. This is a request to use Water Loss Surcharge Funds to pay for the items that were purchased and installed in an area in the district.

(a) If it is a request to use surcharge funds, provide the following

1. A description of the request. 1" bypass meter, gate valve
2. The number of items. We only purchased 1 bypass meter and 1 gate valve
3. The location that the items will be installed. Installed at 11651 Campton Rd
4. Who will be installing the items and the cost of the labor, if not performed by Powell's Valley Water District employee. See attached invoice from Ledford Excavation
5. How the items relate to Powell's Valley Water Districts qualified infrastructure improvement plan. As approved before in our QIIP the valve was needed in an area that we thought was due to water loss. This will isolate the area to see how much water is going there.

(b) If the document was not a request to use surcharge funds, explain. We will use surcharge funds to reimburse to our main account that was already paid out.

2. Refer to the order issued April 1, 2026, page 3 ordering paragraph 1.

(a) State whether Powell's Valley Water District has purchased the approved truck. By the time we got the approval to purchase the truck the manufacturer had already quit making the 2026 models, so the district had to wait until they started the 2027 models. We were informed that the price would increase from \$42,125.00 to \$45,125.00. With the price increasing Powell's Valley Water District is requesting to use \$42,125.00 from the water loss surcharge funds to purchase the truck and the remaining \$3,000.00 will be paid from our main account. We just received the purchase agreement for the new truck on July 7, 2026 please see attached.

(b) If so, provide proof of the expenditure from the water loss surcharge account. We haven't transferred funds from this account yet.

(c) If not, provide an update as to when Powell's Valley Water District plans to purchase the truck. Powell's Valley Water District will purchase the truck on July 9, 2026. Once we get the checks printed out for the dealership I will send in a copy of the check and put the break down as to what will come out of the water loss surcharge account and what will be paid out of our main account.
