Dear Justin:

We are sorry you were unable to attend the meeting of our wholesale customers on March 6, 2024. Attached is the information we shared at the meeting. If you have any questions or want to discuss any of the information please let us know.

Louisville Water is proposing a wholesale rate increase effective July 1, 2024. The rate for wholesale water service on and after July 1, 2024 will be \$2.19 per thousand gallons, plus an elevated service area surcharge of \$0.53 per thousand gallons, for a total wholesale rate of \$2.72 per thousand gallons. This represents a 3.4% increase of our current rate. In addition, your monthly service charge will increase from \$150.72 to \$157.95 per meter, for a total overall increase of 3.07% - 3.44% as indicated in your attached monthly billing analysis.

We are planning to file the necessary documentation for this proposed new rate with the Public Service Commission (PSC) near the end of March. The PSC has advised us in the past that we must inform you of the proposed rate increase in the format of the notice attached on the next page, although we have already provided this information at our wholesale customer meeting March 6, 2024.

We missed Hardin County No. 1 at the meeting – you are a valued member of our wholesale customer group! If you would like us to come to your office and go over in greater detail what was discussed please let us know.
