PROPOSED CUSTOMER NOTICE

Due to Purchased Water Cost increases from the United States Treasury Department, Louisville Water Company, and Hardin County Water District, No. 2, notice is hereby given that Hardin County Water District, No. 1, has filed an application for a Purchased Water Adjustment with the Kentucky Public Service Commission for the purpose of adjusting its Retail and Wholesale water rates. Customer rates will increase by \$0.05 per 1,000 gallons used. The proposed change will be effective for service rendered on or after September 24, 2024.

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The monthly bill for a customer using an average of 4,500 gallons per month will increase \$.23 from \$42.20 to \$42.43 or 0.53%.

The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by Hardin County Water District No. 1. However, the Public Service Commission may order rates to be charged that differ from these proposed rates. Such action may result in rates for consumers other than the rates in this notice.

Any corporation, association, body politic or person may request to intervene, by motion within thirty (30) days after notice of the proposed rate change is given. A motion to intervene shall be in writing and submitted to the Executive Director, Public Service Commission, P.O. Box 615, Frankfort, KY 40602, and shall set forth the grounds for the motion, including the status and interest of the party movant.

Upon request from an intervener, the District shall furnish to the intervener a copy of the application and supporting documents.
